3. Supplies

- College ruled composition book, one per half-semester, for notes *and* assignments.
- *Required.* TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator. Pricy, but will be used in Precalculus and Calculus. ←

4. Grading

- 70% of the grade will be based on periodic assessments (quizzes and tests)
- 30% of the grade will be based on homework, miscellaneous class assignments, and class participation
- **class participation** includes adherence to school policies: no big backpacks in class, visible ID, uniform (*especially*: no hoodies, collared shirt visible), being on time, etc, and positive classroom behavior. ←

5. Late daily homework, make-ups

- Unexcused late homework will receive half credit *unless* accompanied by an “excused late homework” voucher. Each student will receive five of these at the beginning of the semester.
- Homework will receive *no credit* after the test covering that homework.
- School policy regarding make-up work applies.
- *Note: If a student is away from class on a school activity, he/she will be expected to have any previously-assigned work from the missing period ready upon return from the activity.* ←
- Each student is responsible for scheduling his/her own make-up quiz and test sittings with me. *I will neither remind nor pursue the student.* ←
