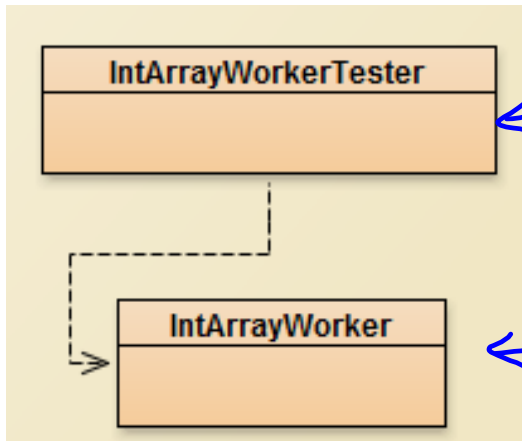

For example, you can make a new picture ("`smallMyPicture.jpg`" in the `images` folder) one-fourth the size of the original ("`myPicture.jpg`") using:

```
Picture p = new Picture("myPicture.jpg");
Picture smallP = p.scale(0.25,0.25);
smallP.write("smallMyPicture.jpg");
```
